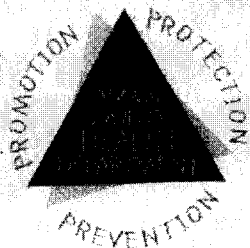

# Western Illinois Agri-Health Program



Dedicated to the prevention  
and early detection of  
agricultural related health  
problems and to increasing  
awareness of rural health and  
safety issues.

Agricultural workers are at risk for numerous health problems due to the diverse nature of agricultural occupations and the variety of agricultural work environments.

Awareness of the risks involved and knowledge of how to prevent agricultural related injuries and disease is the goal of the Agri-Health Program of East Adams County Rural Health Center (EAC). In cooperation with Western Illinois Area Health Education Center (AHEC), EAC and Blessing Hospital are offering this program to all rural citizens of Western Illinois.

### *The Agri-Health Program*

- Provides screening for illnesses and injuries caused by long-term exposures to noise, vibrations, sun, dust, and chemicals associated with farming and other agribusinesses.
- Tracks the health of participants over time.
- Increases awareness of farm associated health injuries.
- Promotes prevention of illnesses associated with farm living.

If you work on a farm or are engaged in an agricultural occupation, this program may improve your health and quality of life.

#### *Farm Risk Evaluation \$30*

Includes:

- 1) General health review including height, weight, blood pressure measurements, etc.
- 2) Skin cancer screening
- 3) Risk assessment for ag related disease/injury
- 4) Specific educational materials related to your areas of risk
- 5) Results recorded to track risk from year to year

#### *Additional Screening Available*

If you are at risk for specific problems, the following tests may be recommended:

Hearing Test	\$20
Lung Screening	\$30

Additional screenings or tests may be made if warranted.

This program is a targeted prevention education/screening program. It is not to take place of your regular check up. If specific illnesses are discovered through this program, you will be referred to your primary care physician for further evaluation.
